NOTICE OF INTENT (NOI) INSTRUCTIONS

The purpose of this form is to assist you in providing the correct information for your “*Notice of Intent*” to apply restricted materials.

You must file a “Notice of Intent” at least 24 hours before applying restricted materials. We recommend that you use this form as a guideline when filing a “*Notice of Intent*”.

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. NAME: Use the Name listed on the Pesticide Permit.
2. SITE ID: Use the exact Site ID as listed on the Pesticide Permit.

If you have more than one Site ID to treat with the same pesticide/rate/volume, give List each Site ID and acreage.

EXAMPLE / SITE ID

1 – 3	10 acres
3 - 1	12 acres
4 – 2	15 acres

If the “NOI” is not complete and accurate it may be necessary to delay the pesticide application until we have the necessary information.
