E-60 <b>Sep. 3, 2010</b>	<b>Special Vote by Mail ballots are issued (Military)</b> EC 300(b), 3103
E-40 to E-21 <b>Sep. 23 to Oct. 12, 2010</b>	<b>State pamphlets mailed out</b> (EC 9094), check with the Registrar for the exact mailing date
E-40 to E-10 <b>Sep. 23 to Oct. 23, 2010</b>	<b>Counties mail sample ballots</b> , check with Registrar for the exact date. EC 13303, 13304
