MEMO TO: SUTTER COUNTY CHILDREN & FAMILIES COMMISSION

SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF AGREEMENT FOR ORAL HEALTH INITIATIVE

BACKGROUND: In January of 2004, the Commission approved a five year Oral Health Initiative. The initiative includes purchasing a mobile dental vehicle from Commission reserves and the allocation of \$150,000 per year for 5 years to support ongoing costs of the dental program. Yuba City Unified School District has indicated its willingness to participate in this program as fiscal agent. This initiative is an expansion of the current fiscal year 03-04 Commission funded direct service grant "Sutter County Smiles" and will continue the efforts of the Commission to improve the oral health status of young children in Sutter County.

CURRENT PROPOSAL: Yuba City Unified School District has agreed to provide Oral Health services in accordance with the Sutter County Children & Families Commission Oral Health Initiative. The Agreement defines the responsibilities of the Commission and the District.

RECOMMENDATION: It is the recommendation of the Executive Director to enter into an agreement with Yuba City Unified School District for Oral Health Services.

IMPACT ON COMMISSION RESOURCES: As previously discussed and approved by the Commission, allocate \$150,000 per year for 5 years for support of the initiative.

POLICY ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of Executive Director's recommendation.
