Mountain Men Program for Children at Museum

Back by popular demand, the Sierra Muzzleloaders from Brownsville will set up camp in the Howard Harter Park behind the Community Memorial Museum of Sutter County on Wednesday, July 16 at 10:00 a.m. Children and families are invited to the demonstration of frontier skills, such as making a fire, chipping arrowheads from stone, and explanations of skills and knowledge needed to survive in the wilderness. The Muzzleloaders will appear in full costume and set up a camp outfitted with authentic representations of the colorful mountain man era of the early 1800s. Guests are invited to try their hands at some of the skills during the historical event.
