March 3, 2020

Polls open at 7:00am and close at 8:00pm

Offices up for election requiring a filing fee: US Rep in Congress, State Assembly, Judge Superior Court Dept. 1 and 4 and Supervisor Districts 1, 4 and 5.

Sep. 12, to Nov. 6, 2019 E-173 to E-118	Signature in Lieu of Filing Fee , signatures can be obtained at this time to satisfy the filing fee in full or in part. These signatures can also be applied to the nomination signatures if filed by Nov. 6, 2019. EC 8061, 8105, 8106(b)(3)
Sep. 27, to Dec. 6, 2019 E-158 to E-88	Filing of Declaration of Candidacy and Nomination Papers for Party Central Committees. EC 8001 and 8020
Oct. 28, to Nov. 6, 2019 E-127 to E-118	Judicial candidates file Declaration of Intent (Judicial Candidates only); candidate filing fees are paid when this document is filed. EC 8023 and 8105(b)
Nov. 7, to Nov. 11, 2019 E-117 to E-113	Declaration of Intent extension is granted (for non-incumbents) if an incumbent judge does not file a Declaration of Intent (Judicial Candidates Only). EC 8023
Nov. 11, to Dec. 6, 2019 E-113 to E-88	Filing of Declaration of Candidacy and Nomination Papers for all candidates and the payment of the nonrefundable filing fee. The optional Candidate statements 200 words or less and for State Candidates 250 words or less are filed when the Declaration of Candidacy is filed. EC 10510, 13307 Candidate Statements may be withdrawn but not changed by 5pm the next working day after the close of the nomination period. EC 13307(3) Form 700 Candidate Statement of Economic Interest – filing deadline for all candidates (except US Senate and Congress) who have not submitted a Form 700 within the previous 60 days. Gov. Dec. 7, to Dec. 11, 2019 E-87 to E-83	Candidate Nomination Extension Period (only for non-incumbents) if an incumbent does not file by Dec. 6, 2019. This provision does not apply if there is no incumbent to be elected, if the incumbent has met the term limit or Central Committee candidates. EC 8022, 8024, 8204
Dec. 12, 2019 E-82	Random Alpha Draw 11a.m. Conducted by the Secretary of State to determine candidate name order as it will appear on the ballot. The County Election Official will also hold a drawing at 11:00 a.m. for legislative offices. EC 13112
Jan. 3, 2020 E-60	Military and Overseas ballots issued. EC 3105
Jan. 6, to Feb. 18, 2020 E-57 to E-14	Write-In Candidate Filing EC 8600, 8601
Feb. 3 to Feb. 25, 2020 E-29 to E-7	Vote by Mail Ballot Mailing and processing period for Vote by Mail ballots. Ballots will be available at the County Elections Office. EC 3001
Feb. 17, 2020 E-15	Last Day to Register to Vote for this Election EC 2107
