

PRESIDENTIAL GENERAL ELECTION - TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2020

July 13 – August 7 (E-113 to E-88)	<p>Candidate Nomination Period – All Candidates Candidates (including incumbents) must file Nomination documents with the County Election Official during this period. If applicable, the <u>Nonrefundable filing fee</u> (money, signatures or any prorated combination of both) shall be paid at the time the candidate obtains their nomination forms. EC 8105</p> <p>The Candidate Statement of Qualifications shall be filed when candidate's Declaration of Candidacy is filed. Statements may not be changed but may be withdrawn and timely re-filed. Final day to withdraw is 5:00 p.m. of the next business day after close of nomination period. EC 8020, 8028, 8060-8063, 8801, 10220, 10510, 13307(a)(3)</p> <p>Form 700 Candidate Statement of Economic Interest filing deadline for all candidates, except US Senate and Congress, who have not submitted a Form 700 within the previous 60 days. Gov. Code 87100-87314</p>
July 28 (E-98)	<p>Ballot Designation Change Deadline for Run-Off Candidates Last day that a candidate can submit a written request to change their ballot designation as used in the primary election. EC 13107(e).</p> <p>Deadlines for Filing Arguments: Deadlines will be determined by the Elections Official. EC 9163</p>
August 7 (E-88)	<p>Close of Regular Candidate Nomination Period Candidate nomination documents are due. Incumbents who wish to file as a candidate for their own office must file by this date. Last day to withdraw declaration of candidacy papers except when there is an extension to that office.</p> <p>Form 700 Statements of Economic Interest are due. EC 8020, GC 87200</p>
August 7 (E-88)	<p>Last Day for Governing Bodies to Submit a Measure Resolution Measures are to be submitted to the Board of Supervisors requesting consolidation with this election. EC 10403</p>
August 8 – August 12 (E-87 to E-83)	<p>Extension of Candidate Nomination Period Extension period for anyone other than the incumbent if the incumbent did not file by E-88. Does not apply if there is no incumbent to be re-elected. EC 10225, 10407, 10516, 10603</p>
August 12 (E-83)	<p>Write-In Campaign Against Incumbent Judge Running Unopposed for General Election Last day to file a petition indicating that a write-in campaign will be conducted against an unopposed incumbent superior court judicial candidate who has filed Nomination Papers. The petition must signed by at least 0.1% or 100 registered voters, whichever is greater, qualified to vote with respect to the office. Once the petition is complete, write-in candidates must file their write-in statement and nomination papers between September 7th (E-57) and October 20th (E-14). EC 8203, 8600-8604</p>
August 13 11 a.m. (E-82)	<p>Randomized Alphabet Drawing Conducted by the Secretary of State to determine candidate name order as it will appear on local ballot. The County Election Official will also hold a drawing at 11:00 a.m. for multi-county legislative offices. EC 13112</p>
September 4 (E-60)	<p>Military and Overseas Ballot Requests First day the County Elections Official may process applications for special vote by mail ballot requests for Military, Overseas and 60-day voters. EC 300(b), 3103</p>
September 7- October 20 (E-57 to E-14)	<p>Write-In Candidate Filing Write-In candidates file Declaration of Candidacy and Nomination documents during this time. EC 8600-8604</p>
September 24 (E-40)	<p>County Sample Ballot Pamphlets mailed to each registered voter.</p> <p>State Voter Information Guides mailed to each household. EC 9094, 13303</p>
October 5 (E-29)	<p>Vote by Mail Ballot Mailing and processing period for Vote by Mail ballots. Ballots will be available Sutter County Elections. EC 3001</p>
October 19 (E-15)	<p>Last Day to Register for this election. Postmarks, DMV and personal delivery are acceptable. EC 2107</p>
November 3(E)	<p>ELECTION DAY Polls are open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. EC 1000, 14212</p>
November 5 – December 3 (E+2 to E+30)	<p>Canvass of the Vote The official canvass of precinct returns shall commence and be completed during this time. The County Election Official shall prepare a certified statement of the results and submit it to the governing bodies involved with this election. EC15301, 15372</p>
