

CERTIFIED UNIFIED PROGRAM AGENCY (CUPA) FEES

- I. Business Plans:
  - A. Category 1..... \$ 105.00  
Handles, stores or dispenses hazardous materials in the following quantities:  
55 gallons to 1,200 gallons,  
500 pounds to 1,000 pounds,  
200 cubic feet to 500 cubic feet of compressed gases.
  - B. Category 2..... \$ 210.00  
Handles, stores or dispenses hazardous materials in the following quantities:  
1,201 gallons to 10,000 gallons,  
1,001 pounds to 3,000 pounds,  
501 cubic feet to 1,000 cubic feet of compressed gases.
  - C. Category 3..... \$ 315.00  
Handles, stores or dispenses hazardous materials in the following quantities:  
>10,001 gallons, >3,001 pounds, or >1,001 cubic feet of compressed gases.
  - D. Category 4..... \$ 420.00  
Handles, stores, or dispenses one or more extremely hazardous materials.
  - E. Category 5..... \$ 210.00  
UST retail facilities (gas station).
- II. Underground Storage Tanks (Annual Regulatory Fee/Tank Permit per site):
  - A. Up to 2 Tanks .....\$ 840.00
  - B. 3 – 5 Tanks per site .....\$ 1,050.00
  - C. 6 or more Tanks per site .....\$ 1,155.00
- III. Hazardous Waste (Annual Fee):
  - A. Category 1..... \$ 157.50  
Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generators (CESQG),  
Generate <27 gallons per month of hazardous waste.
  - B. Category 2..... \$ 262.50  
Small Quantity Generator (SQG), generates >27 gallons per month  
but <270 gallons per month.
  - C. Category 3..... \$ 315.00  
Large Quantity Generator (LQG), generates >270 gallons per month.
  - D. Category 4..... \$ 420.00  
Tiered Permitting – Conditionally Authorized (CA) or Permit By Rule (PBR).

- IV. Cal ARP (California Accident Release Prevention):  
(At Submission of Plan and at Time of Update)
  - A. Cal ARP (Risk Management Plan Review)-At Cost with Deposit ... \$ 2,500.00
  - B. Cal ARP (Risk Management Plan Review, 5 year update).....\$ 1,050.00
  - C. Cal ARP Program Annual Fee .....\$ 349.65
  
- V. Aboveground Petroleum Storage Tank:
  - A. Category 1.....\$ 175.00  
 $\geq 1,320$  gallons and  $\leq 10,000$  gallons aggregate aboveground  
 Petroleum storage capacity.
  - B. Category 2.....\$ 315.00  
 $> 10,000$  gallons aggregate aboveground petroleum storage capacity.
  
- VI. Incidental Fees (At cost):
  - A. Site Remediation .....\$ 105.00/hr
  - B. Re-inspection .....\$ 105.00/hr
  - C. Overtime.....\$ 157.50/hr
  - D. Tank Closure in Place .....\$ 105.00/hr
  - E. Temporary Closure .....\$ 105.00/hr
  - F. Transfer/Amend Permit.....\$ 105.00/hr
  - G. Plan Check/Install AST/UST .....\$ 105.00/hr
  - H. Tank Removal .....\$ 105.00/hr
  - I. Modify/Tank Repair .....\$ 105.00/hr

  - A. Late Charge 30 days past due.....10%
  - B. Late Charge 60 days past due.....25%
