

Risk Management Plans (RMPs) have been submitted by Lomo Cold Storage, 6005 Highway 99, Live Oak, CA 95953 and Bear River Supply, Inc., 218 Pleasant Grove Road, Rio Oso, CA 95674. The RMP describes programs and controls designed to prevent accidental releases of regulated substances. These RMPs will be available for public review and comment for the next 45 days at the Sutter County Development Services Department, 1130 Civic Center Boulevard, Suite A, Yuba City, CA, 95993.

Such a plan is required under the California Accidental Release Prevention Program, implemented in January of 1997. The purpose of the program is to prevent accidental releases of substances that can cause serious harm to the public and the environment, to minimize the damage if releases do occur, and to ensure information about the potential hazard is available to the public.

Businesses in Sutter County that produce, handle, process, distribute, or store certain chemicals over a threshold quantity are required to develop a RMP, prepare a RMP and submit the plan to the Environmental Health Division of the Development Services Department.

The plans are to be updated every five years, and are available for public review during regular business hours of the Environmental Health Division.
