Pursuant to Zoning Code Section 1500-23-080 or Subdivision Ordinance Section 1400-850, decisions of the Planning Commission or Director of Development Services may be appealed by an applicant, property owner or any other aggrieved person by completing a Notice of Appeal within ten (10) days after such decision is made. If the tenth day falls on a Saturday or Sunday, then Saturday and Sunday will be considered holidays and the appeal may be filed on the immediately following business day.

The appellate body shall hold a public hearing within 60 days after the filing of a timely appeal.

### Appeal Statement

The appeal shall identify the decision being appealed and shall clearly and concisely state the reason(s) for the appeal. If only certain conditions of approval are being appealed, the specific conditions shall be identified and the specific grounds for appeal of the conditions shall be specified (additional pages may be attached if necessary).

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
